9. Point within a Circle: Such an important symbol, but what can it mean and what does it teach us?

10. Talking Heads: Learn the link between the Craft and Chapter and the icing on the cake in the final step in pure and antient Freemasonry.

11. Royal Arch Symbolism West to East: Light-hearted discussion exploring what various symbols exist in the beautiful ceremony of the Royal Arch.

12. The Platonic bodies: Ever wondered what they are? History and teachings and an opportunity to ponder.

13. The Royal Arch jewel: We wear it proudly but here we consider it closely.

14. The Royal Arch Ceremony: A closer look at the story and its characters. What could it mean to you?

15. Anglo-Saxon weapons: From what was our country forged – what was used.

16. The Five Noble Orders of Architecture: A look at the history and symbolism of that noble Science.

17. Origin of Freemasonry: Was it three 11th/12th monks? Hear the case and be the judge for yourself.

21. Lodges/Chapters of Instruction, Education or Improvement: What are the advantages and potential - a look into ideas and strategies to encourage improvement, enjoyment and satisfaction.

22. On the Edge: Chris Jones discusses his epic coastal walk and his reflections on issues involving mental health and the support he received on his travels.
